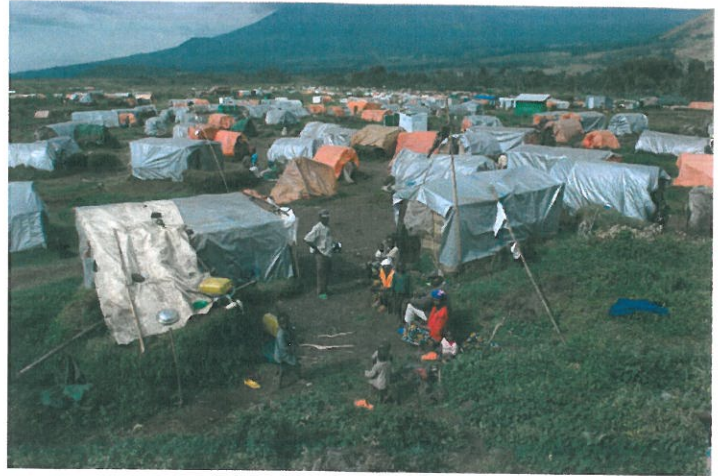


Refugees: Volunteer Training Dates
